Journeyman Lineman

Carroll Electric Cooperative, Inc. is seeking qualified candidates for the position of Journeyman Lineman.

The objective of this position is to perform tasks related to the construction, removal, maintenance, and repair of the Cooperative's electric distribution system. This position will also be responsible for ensuring that all work procedures are in line with the Cooperative safety manual and completing daily vehicle and boom inspections of trucks that are assigned to him/her.

Responsibilities:

Possess and continue to develop these skills and areas of knowledge required, including RUS specifications, National Electric Safety Code, and Cooperative specifications.

Operate equipment and have the knowledge and ability to frame and erect poles, install conductor and transformers, voltage regulators and associated items to meet the overall objectives.

Perform work on energized and de-energized distribution lines.

Provide supervision and leadership in the development of apprentice lineman.

Operate vehicles, tools and equipment in a safe manner and observe all safety rules and regulations.

Takes assigned on-call duty on a rotating basis, providing after-hour work.

Maintains all safety and DOT required certifications, including CDL, CPR, and OSHA required training.

Understands and enforces Cooperative policies and procedures, work rules, and ensures compliance.

May be asked to perform the duties of crew leader when scheduled crew leader is absent.

Attend schools and training sessions as required.

Perform other emergency or operational duties as requested and assigned.

Qualifications:

- Must possess a high school degree or equivalent.
- Maintain a Class A CDL.
- Successfully pass a background check, drug/alcohol test and a physical and knowledge-based pre-hire assessment.

A strong commitment to safety is required.

The awarded candidate will be required to live within 20-minute response of the facility within the first 6 months of employment and is required to be available 24 hours a day, 7 days a week, for scheduled or unscheduled assignments.
